

GIFT AID



Gift Aid is a UK government scheme that allows charities and Community Amateur Sports Clubs (CASCs) to increase the value of donations from UK taxpayers. For every £1 donated, an extra 25p can be reclaimed from HMRC at no cost to the donor.

To be eligible, donations must be made by a UK taxpayer using their own money and not in exchange for goods or services. Charities must hold a valid Gift Aid declaration from the donor and keep accurate records.

Charities can also claim under the Small Donations Scheme for cash or contactless donations of up to £30 where no declaration is available, helping maximise income from everyday giving.
