

TRUSTS AND FOUNDATIONS



Trusts, foundations, and grant fundraising involves applying to charitable organisations, grant-making bodies, and foundations for financial support. This type of fundraising is often project-specific, funding particular initiatives or organisational development, and requires clear proposals and accountability.

Key Features:

- Funding is often earmarked for specific projects or programmes
- Applications require detailed proposals and reporting
- Can provide substantial, multi-year support
- Requires research to identify suitable funders and eligibility criteria

Examples:

- Applying to a community trust to fund a youth programme
- National foundation grants for research or innovation
- Multi-year funding for capacity-building or service expansion
